Residential Property with 1 Dumpster: • 5 Dwelling Units and Above	\$50
Residential Property with 2 and more Dumpsters	\$75
Commercial Property	\$75 per dumpster

The permit is valid from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023. Please submit your permit application and permit fee (payable to **Town of Hudson**) to our office by Wednesday, June 1st.
